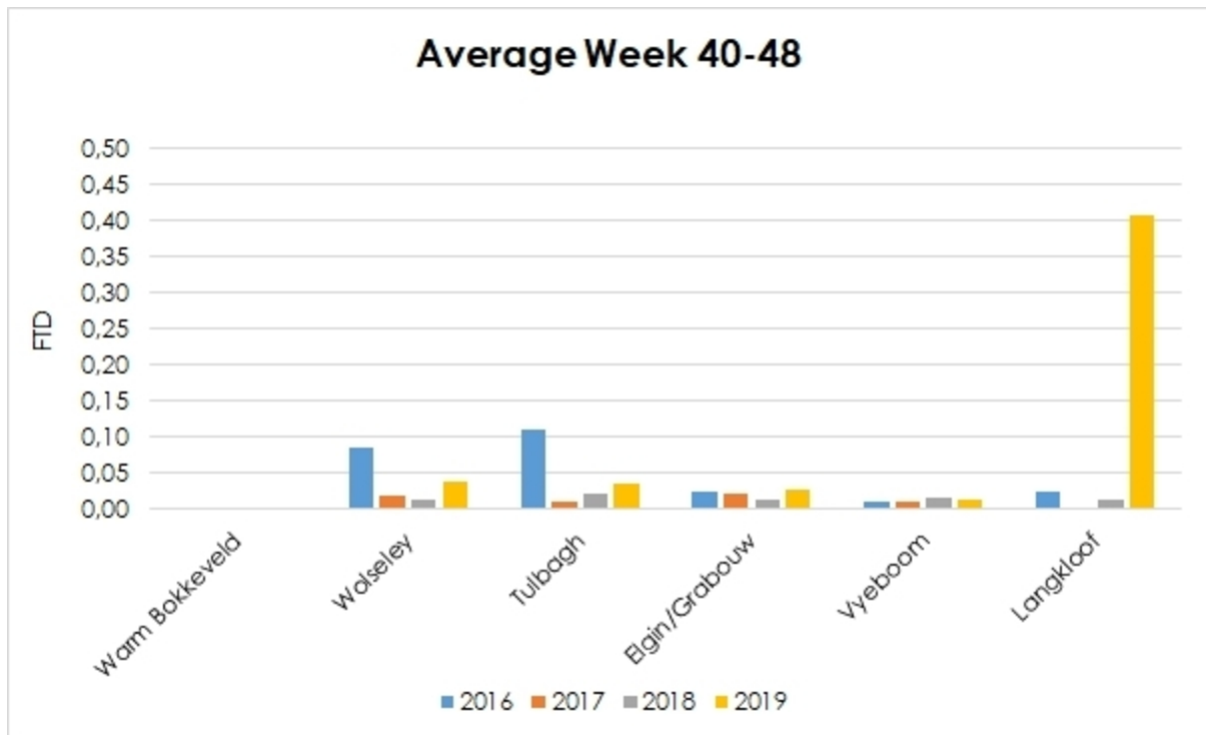

Fruit Fly Count Status

- *These figures represent regions managed by FFA.*
- *Trap catches currently low but increasing.*
- *Fruit fly pressure is increasing in Elgin/Grabouw, Tulbagh and Langkloof production areas.*
- *Week 47 showed spike in counts in Tulbagh.*
- *Average counts in Wolseley, Tulbagh, Elgin and Langkloof are higher this season compared to the same period last year.*
- **Check your weekly counts/trap catches.**
- **Bait weekly and implement orchard sanitation.**

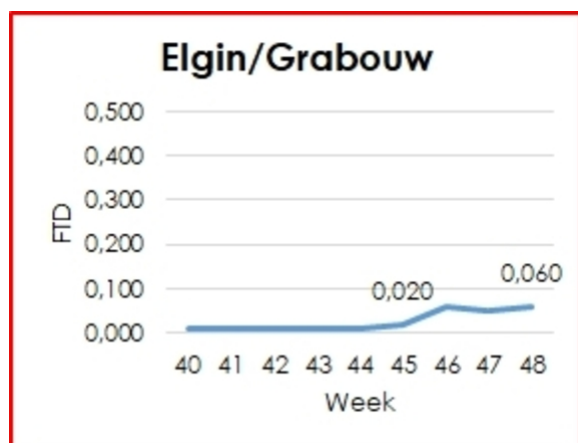
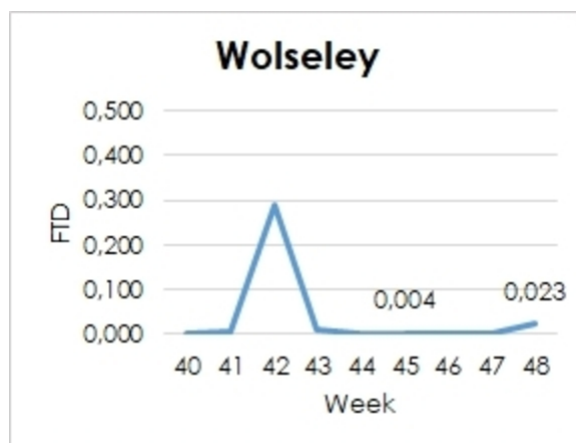
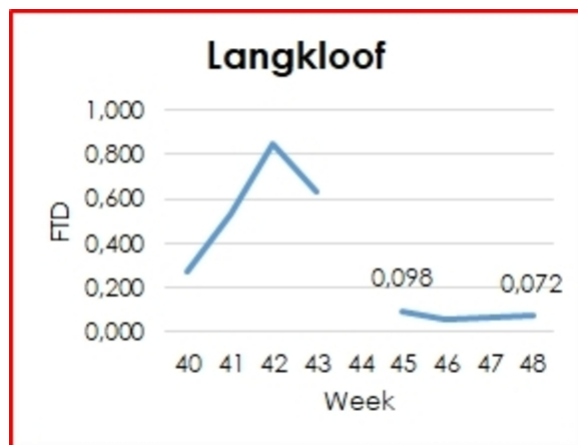
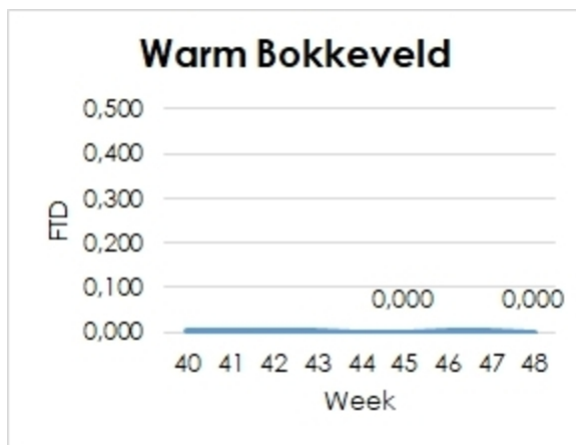
